Brigadier General Bonner F. Fellers, as Psychological Warfare Officer for the Southwest Pacific Area, later United States Army Forces, Pacific, performed meritorious and distinguished service from May to November 1944 and May 1945 to March 1946. He displayed deep insight into the traits of the Japanese and exercised superior ability and initiative in organizing, planning and directing the Psychological Warfare campaign against the Japanese armed forces and home-land population. Through his outstanding professional ability and resourcefulness, General Fellers contributed in a marked degree to Japan's surrender and to the initial success of the military occupation.
